Dear Huntsville Town water customers,

Effective immediately, Huntsville Town will no longer allow its water customers to place their account into "standby" status. The reason for this change is that the Town's cost to provide treated culinary water to its customers is comprised of two separate components. The first, and larger component, is the cost to install and maintain the infrastructure necessary to treat and deliver the water that flows from our spring to your water tap. This cost must be paid regardless of the amount of water that is being used by the customers. The second, and smaller component, is the cost to treat each gallon of water that passes through our treatment plant. The policy of allowing customers who are not using water in any given month to place their account into "standby" status unfairly shifts the cost onto other customers of servicing the debt incurred when the Town installed its water system. The Huntsville Town Council has unanimously voted to end this practice.

This year Huntsville Town will be holding elections for the following offices:

One: 4-year term for Mayor

Two: 4-year terms for Council Member

Any person interested in running for office MUST file their Declaration of Candidacy during the filing period between **June 1st-June 7th**, at the Huntsville Town Hall. Nominating conventions will be held on August 15 @ 7:00 pm, only residents who have previously gone through the Declaration of Candidacy process will be eligible.

Office hours for filing during the week of June 1st -June 7th are: 9AM to 1PM Monday and Wednesday. There will be main-in and physical polling location options available for voters.
