

Huntsville Town Resident Only: Designated Parking Areas

Dear Huntsville Town Residents,

Over the past several years there has been a marked increase in the number of people accessing the lake and the beaches inside Town boundaries. These beach goers tend to park their vehicles in our residential neighborhoods. On any given weekend there will be 30 to 40 vehicles or more parked on both sides of the road at each beach access site.

Along with the increase in vehicles and beach goers has come an increase in abuses being suffered by our residents who live in this area. The amount of trash left on the beach, piled around (but not in) Town provided garbage cans and on private property is extraordinary! We are also experiencing an increase in other issues such as trespassing on private property, human waste issues, indecency issues, speeding, drag racing, etc.

There are designated beach access sites provided and maintained by the Forest Service and American Land and Leisure that should be the primary access for those who wish to recreate at the lake.

In an effort to control these issues and provide relief to the citizens of Huntsville most affected by these abuses, the Town Council is establishing Resident Only Parking Zones. These zones will be clearly posted and non-resident vehicles parked in these locations will be ticketed. Repeat offenders have their vehicles towed away and impounded.

The specific details of this ordinance are as follows:

1. Resident only parking zones will be clearly marked with posted signs. A resident is defined as: citizens who reside in or own property within the town of Huntsville.
2. Any non-resident vehicle parked inside these Resident-Only parking zones will be ticketed by the Weber County Sheriff deputies. Repeat offenders have their vehicles impounded and towed.
3. The Town and the Sheriff's office will monitor the Resident Only parking zones and expand them if needed in order to prevent non-resident parking in these zones.
4. Any resident who lives in these areas, or who wishes to park in these areas, will need a window sticker in their vehicle which will be provided by the town.
5. Hang tag type Guest Passes are also available to all residents. These can be provided to guests of residents who wish to park in Resident-Only parking zones.
6. The Resident-Only parking zones are in effect from May through September.

While this effort may take a while to completely control the issue, we expect this will help resolve the current problems experienced by those who live in these areas of our town. Please contact the Town (Gail Ahlstrom or Mike Engstrom) with any questions and to pick up stickers and hang tags. We appreciate your patience and cooperation while we work through this issue.
