Notice of Proposed Tax Increase:

Huntsville Town is proposing to increase its property tax revenue.

The Huntsville Town tax on a \$334,000 residence would increase from \$216.40 to \$263.61, which is \$47.21 per year. The Huntsville Town tax on a \$334,000 business would increase from \$393.45 to \$479.29, which is \$85.84 per year. If the proposed budget is approved, Huntsville Town would increase its property tax budgeted revenue by 21.81% above last year's property tax budgeted revenue excluding new growth.

The public hearing will be held on August 3, 2017, @ 7:00 p.m. at the Huntsville Town Hall.

Notice of Public Hearing on proposed amendments to the following ordinances:

Title 0: Definitions; clarify verbiage for major, minor, cul-de-sac, and private streets to match proposed amendments to Title 15.25.2.2.

Title 4.2 Land Use and Building Permits Required; clarification of Land Use Permits, Building Permits, Remodel Permits, and Self-Performed Remodel Permits.

Title 15.1: Acceptable Uses in a Zone Table; to allow storage, indoor, commercial as Conditional Use in a Residential Zone.

Title 15.25.2.2: Street and Alley Widths, Cul-de-Sacs, and Easements; to better clarify verbiage for major, minor, cul-de-sac, and private streets.
