

ORDINANCE NO: 2018-04-19

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A FEE TO BE LEVIED WHEN IT IS NECESSARY TO TICKET OR TOW A CAR DUE TO PARKING VIOLATIONS

WHEREAS, it is unlawful to park or cause to be parked any vehicle along the streets designated “No Parking” or “Parking By Permit Only” by a sign or device placed in said area, and,

WHEREAS, it shall also be unlawful to park any vehicle on the side of any street during hours restricted by a posted sign, and

WHEREAS, overnight camping in motor homes, campers, trailers, tents or any vehicle on Huntsville Town property, streets, right-of-ways, alleys, cemetery, or parks is prohibited.

NOWTHEREFORE, it shall be unlawful to park or cause to be parked any vehicle along the streets designated “No Parking” or “Parking By Permit Only” by as sign or device placed in said area, or, everything West of 7300 E. as being a no roadside parking area during the months of May-September 30th. (Ord 12.5.C)

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF HUNTSVILLE TOWN, WEBER COUNTY, UTAH, THAT:

1. The violation of this Ordinance shall be an infraction punishable by a fine schedule explained below and/or the vehicle towed or impounded at the owner expense.
 - *Not less than 5 days nor more than 14 days of issuance of the citation, you must remit payment of \$50.00 (Ord 42-4-8) to the Weber County Sheriff's Office or online <http://webercountyutah.gov/ParkingCitation/parkg.php> or request a hearing (Ord 42-4-12).*
 - *After 14 days, fine increases after to \$100.00 (Ord 42-4-8). After 28 days, fine may be sent to collections (Ord 42-4-9 and Ord 42-4-15).*
2. Parking in violation of this section is hereby declared to be a public nuisance, and said vehicle may be removed summarily by Huntsville Town by towing.
3. The Weber County Sheriff's Office is authorized to enforce the “No Parking” or “Parking by Permit Only” ordinance.

4. The owner or operator of a vehicle cited for illegal parking under this ordinance shall be required to, in addition of paying the penalty, pay towing fees and impound fees for the release of the vehicle. Towing fees may be levied against the violator or the owner of the vehicle, or both.

5. If a vehicle has 3 or more parking violations, the car will be towed at the owner's expense, plus a \$250.00 fine to get the car out of impound.

6. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately.
